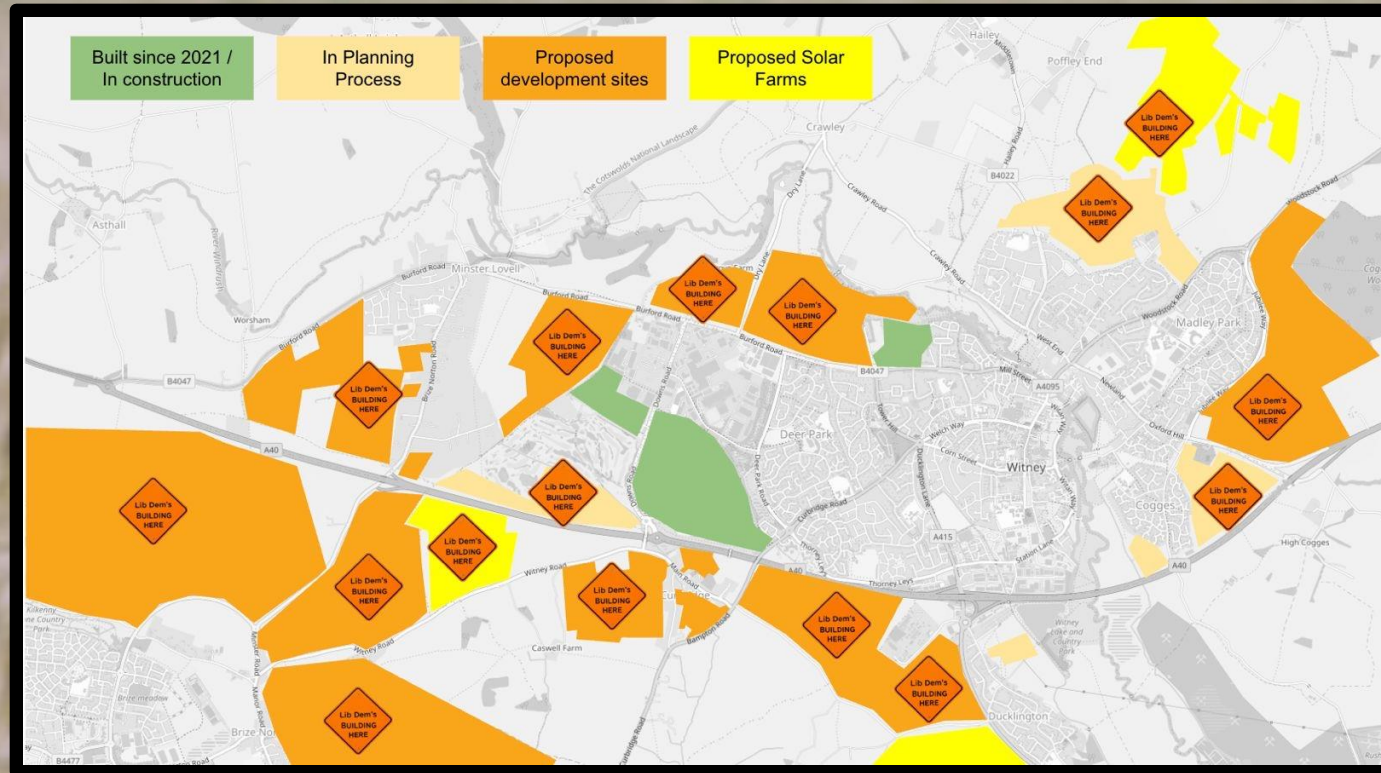
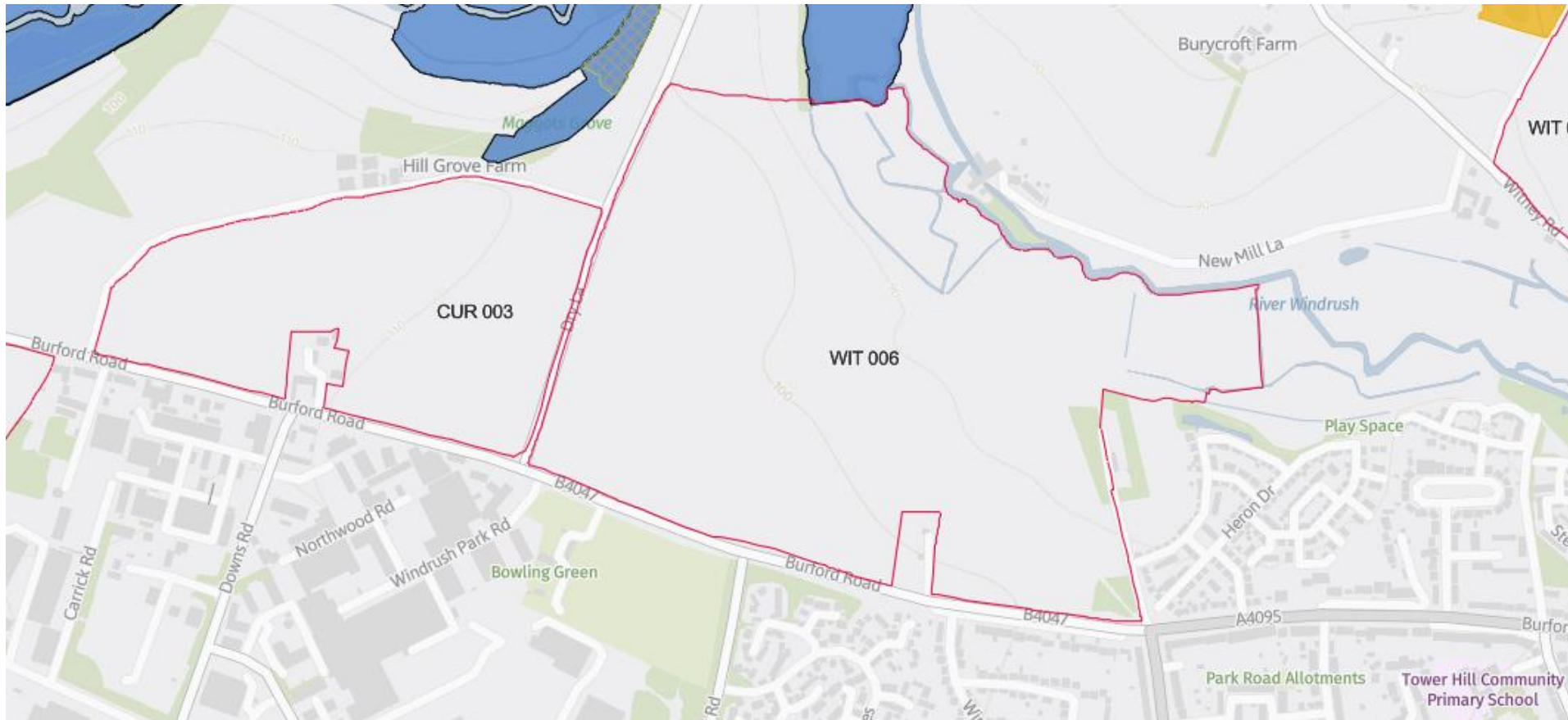


Lib Dem Local Plan Review: 18,000 more houses in West Oxfordshire...

- WIT 006 is up to 900 houses and CUR 003 is up to 400 houses.



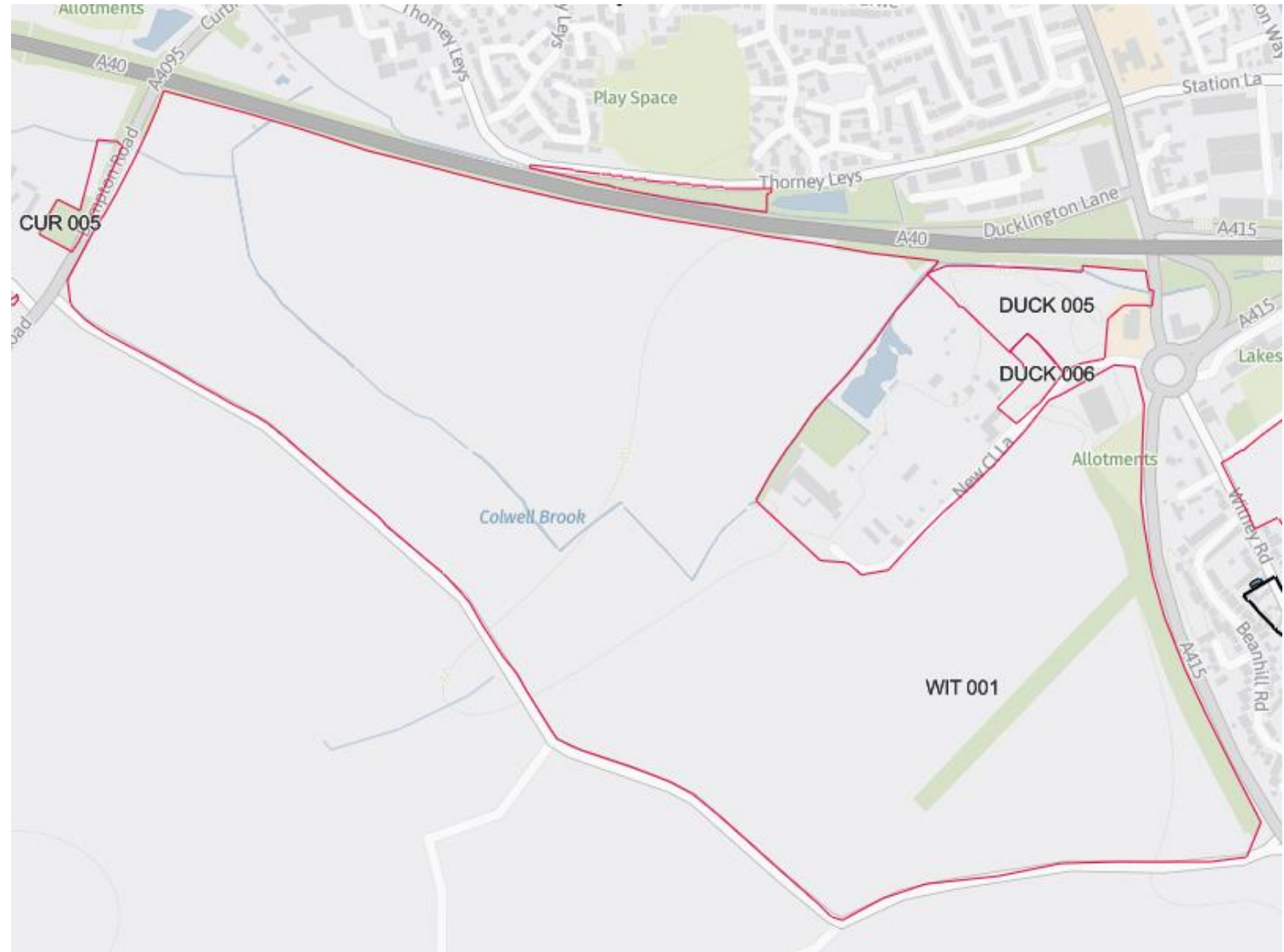
Minster Lovell

- MIN 006 is up to 700 houses
- MIN 002 is 950-1,250 houses.



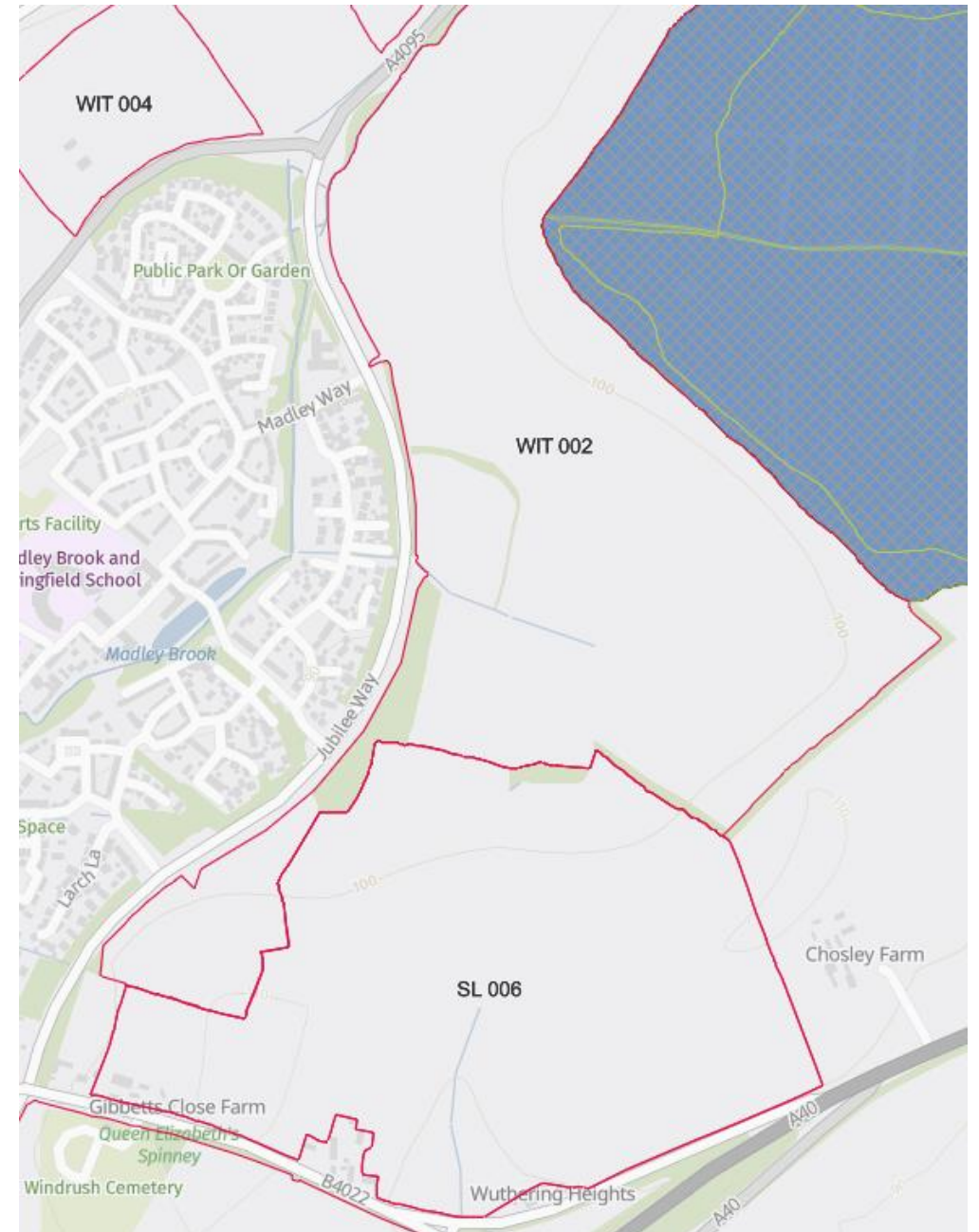
Ducklington

- WIT 001 is up to 1,800 houses.



Witney East

- SL 006 up to 450 houses.
- WIT 002 up to 300 houses.



Shilton Part 1

- Land west of Shilton Road is up to 100 houses. Unsure which site but likely SHIL 002.



Shilton Part 2

- Land north of Price Way has no figure given but likely to be up to 300 potentially given the size of the site.



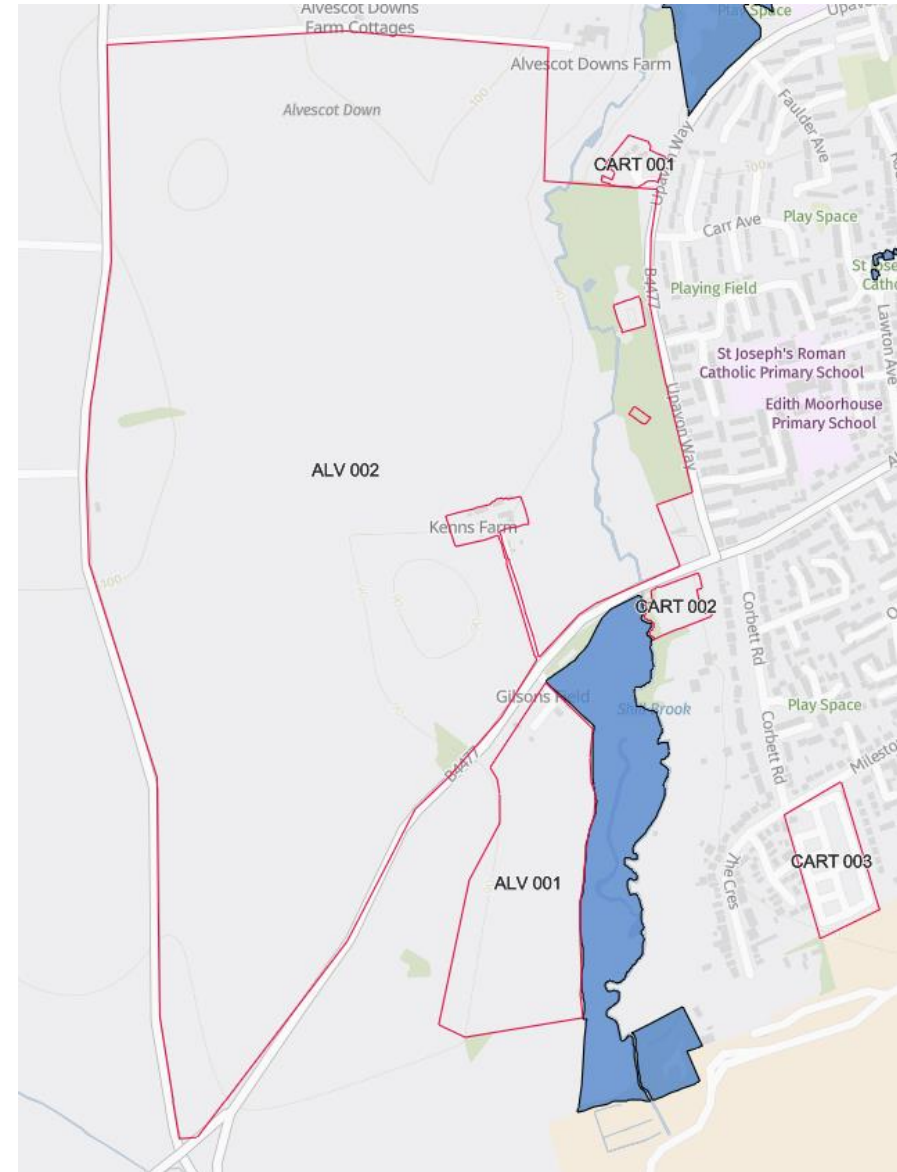
Carterton North

- Land at Kilkenny Farm is expected to be over 750 houses. (BN 001)



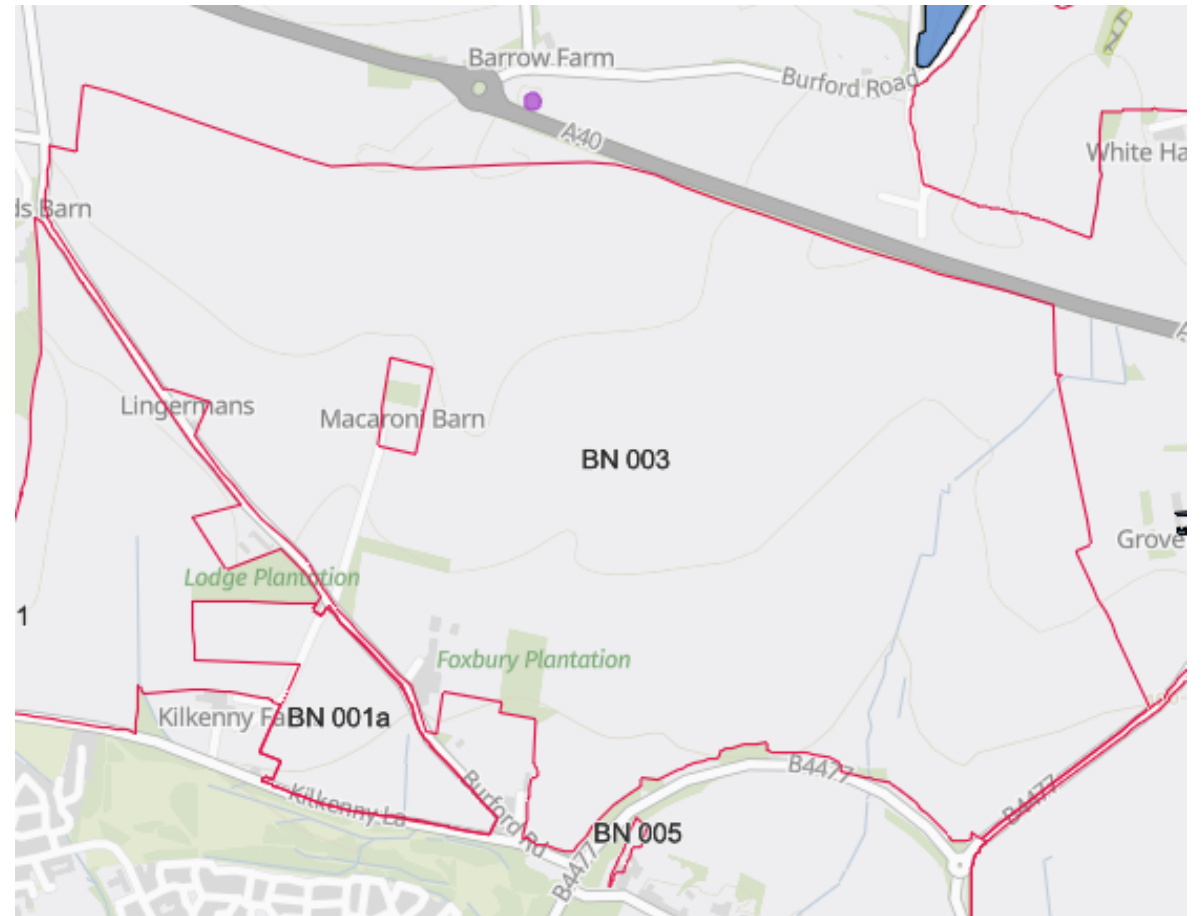
Carterton West

- Land west of Carterton has been talked about many times before. No figures given but likely to be a couple of hundred at least.



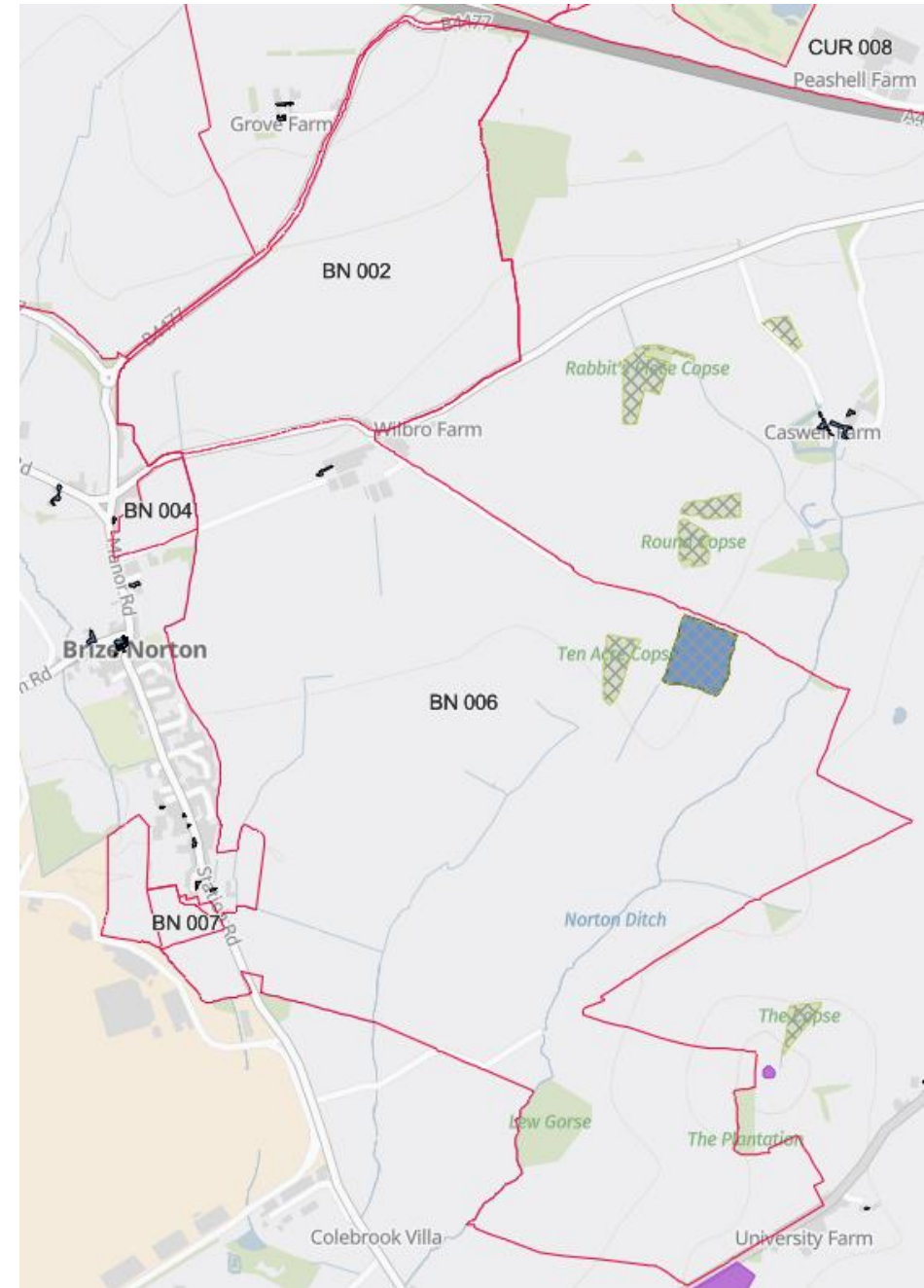
Brize Norton Part 1

- BN 003 is for up to 3,000 houses.
- BN 001a is for 350 houses and the planning application has been received already.



Brize Norton Part 2

- No figures found for these sites but given the large size these sites could be significant strategic housing sites.



Chipping Norton

- CHIP 006 could be up to 450 houses.

Not shown on this map is also:

- Land east of Burford Road for 100 houses.
- Land west of Burford Road for 200 houses.



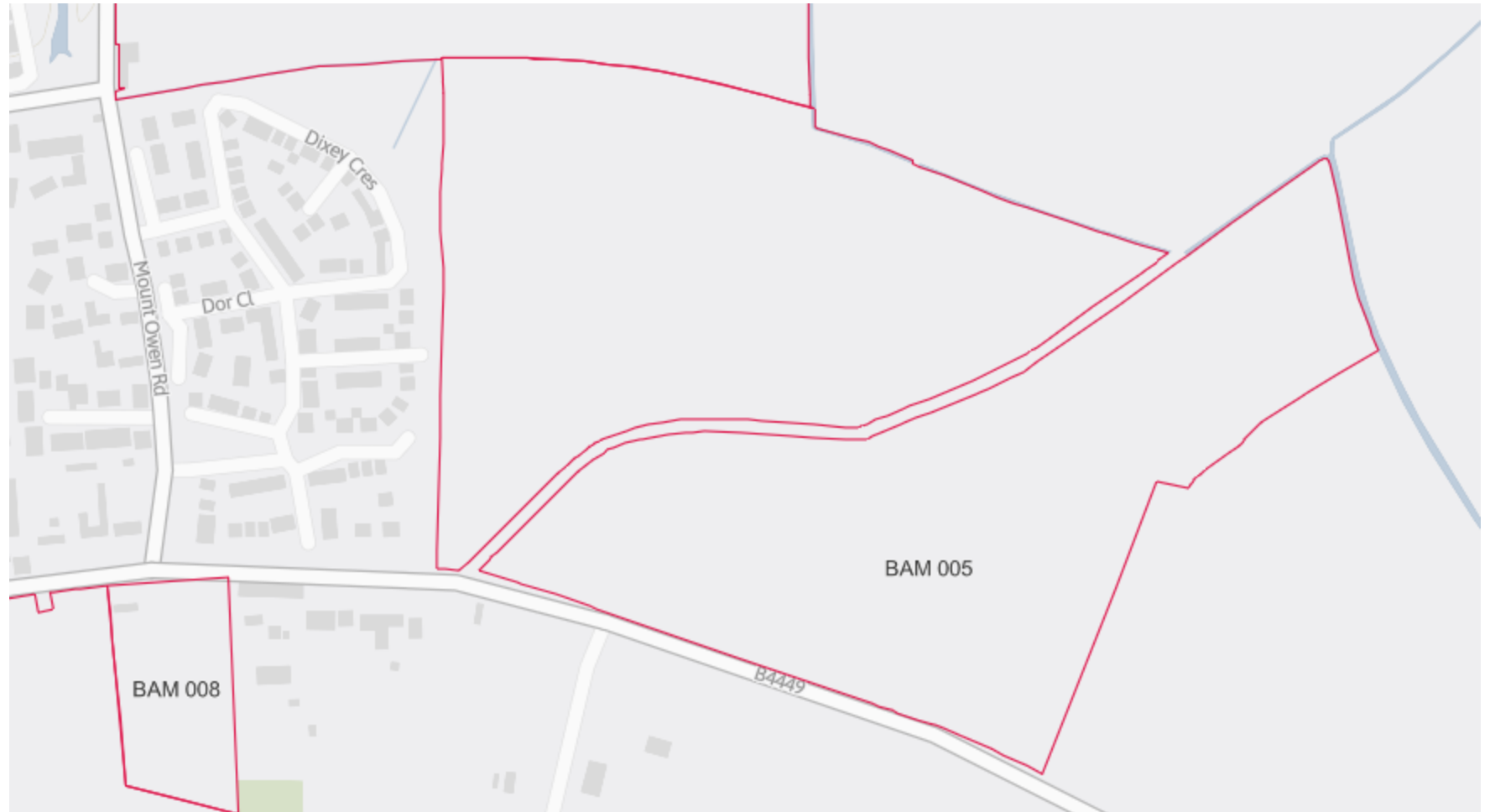
Bampton Part 1

- No figures shown for these sites but given the size (67ha combined) this would likely be a large strategic housing site.



Bampton Part 2

- Land north of Aston Road (BAM 005) is up to 300 houses.



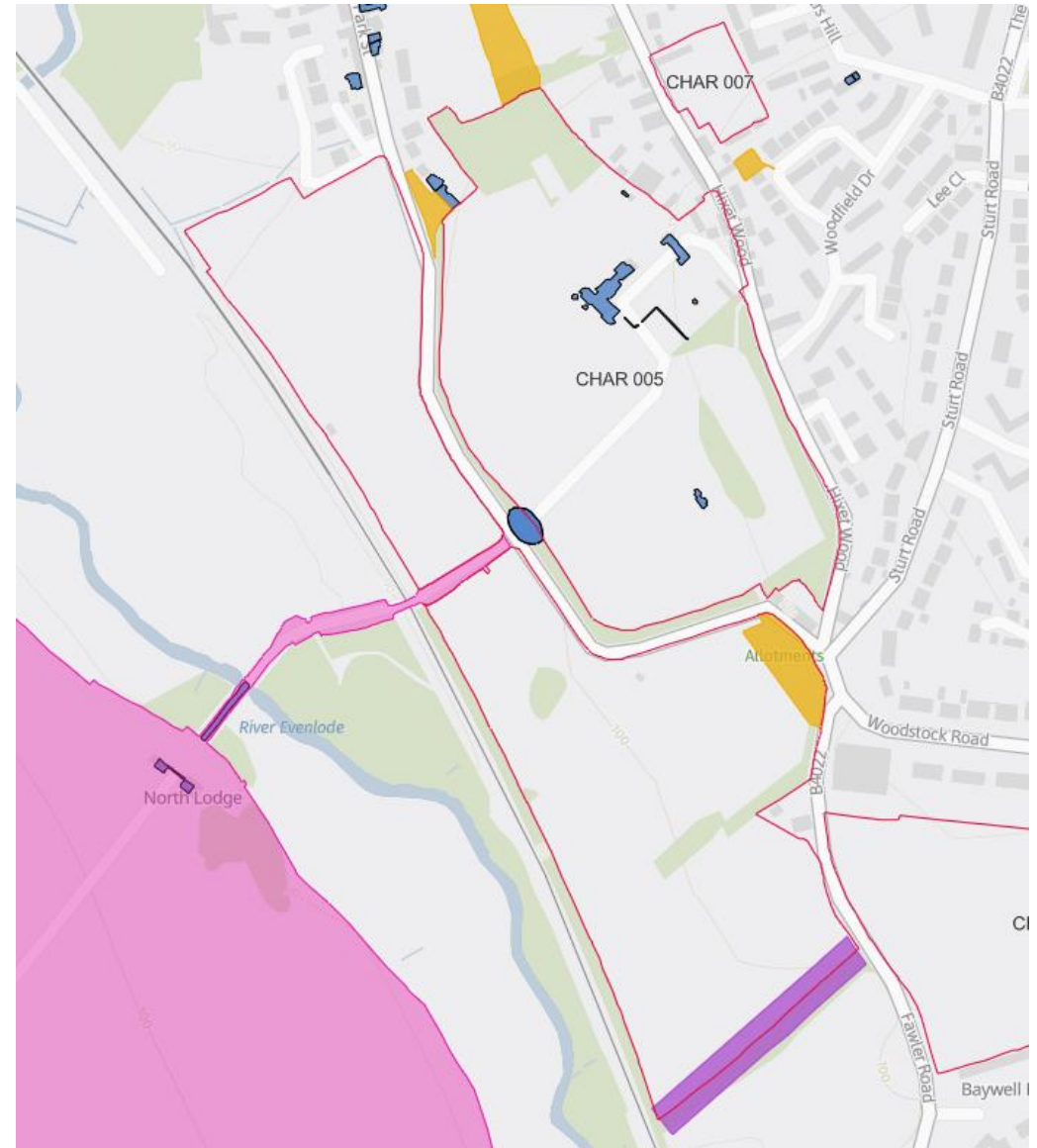
Burford

- Land south of Sheep Street (BUR 002) no figures given but given the site is 20ha this is likely to be a strategic site option.



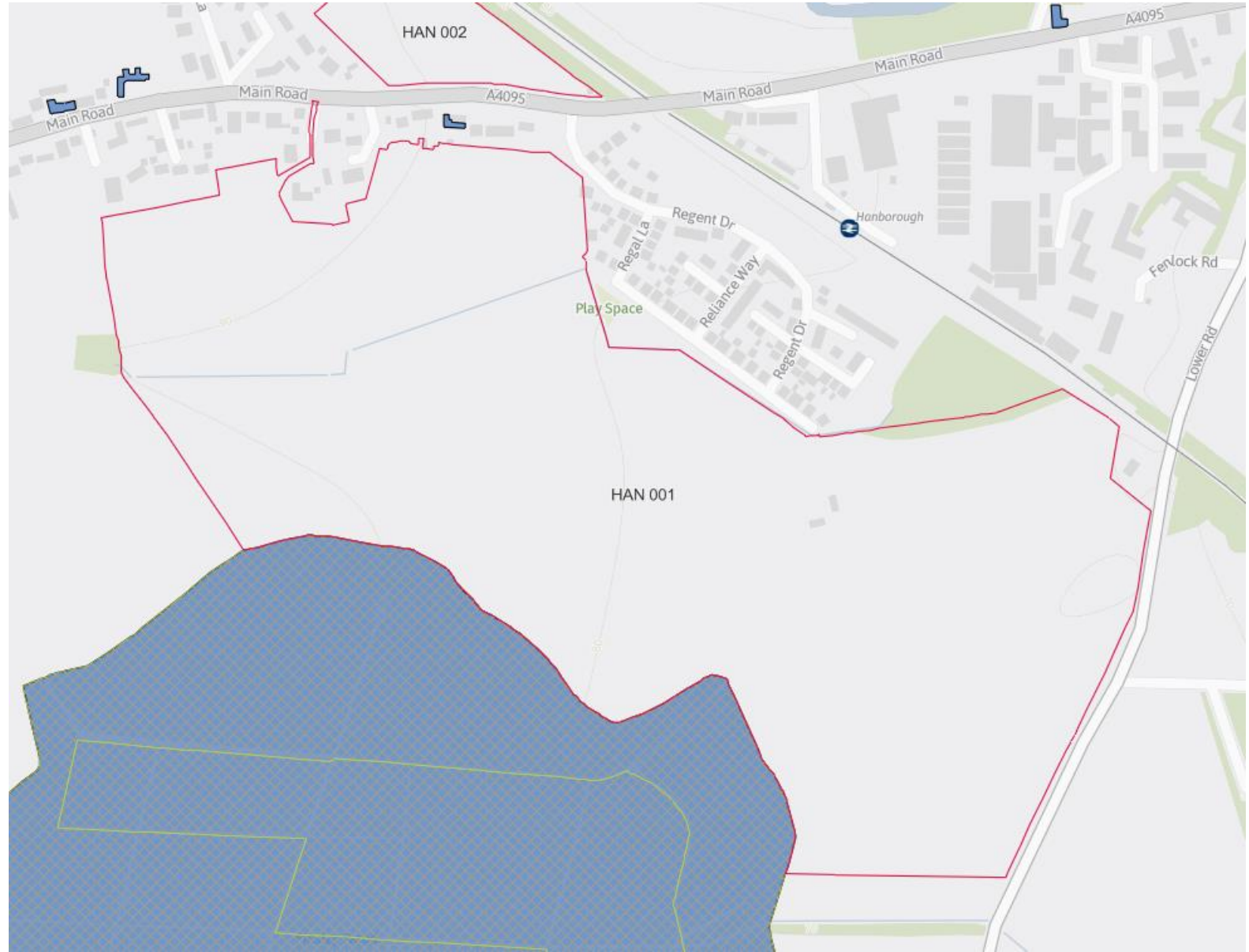
Charlbury

- Land south and west of Charlbury (CHAR 005) is up to 50 houses.



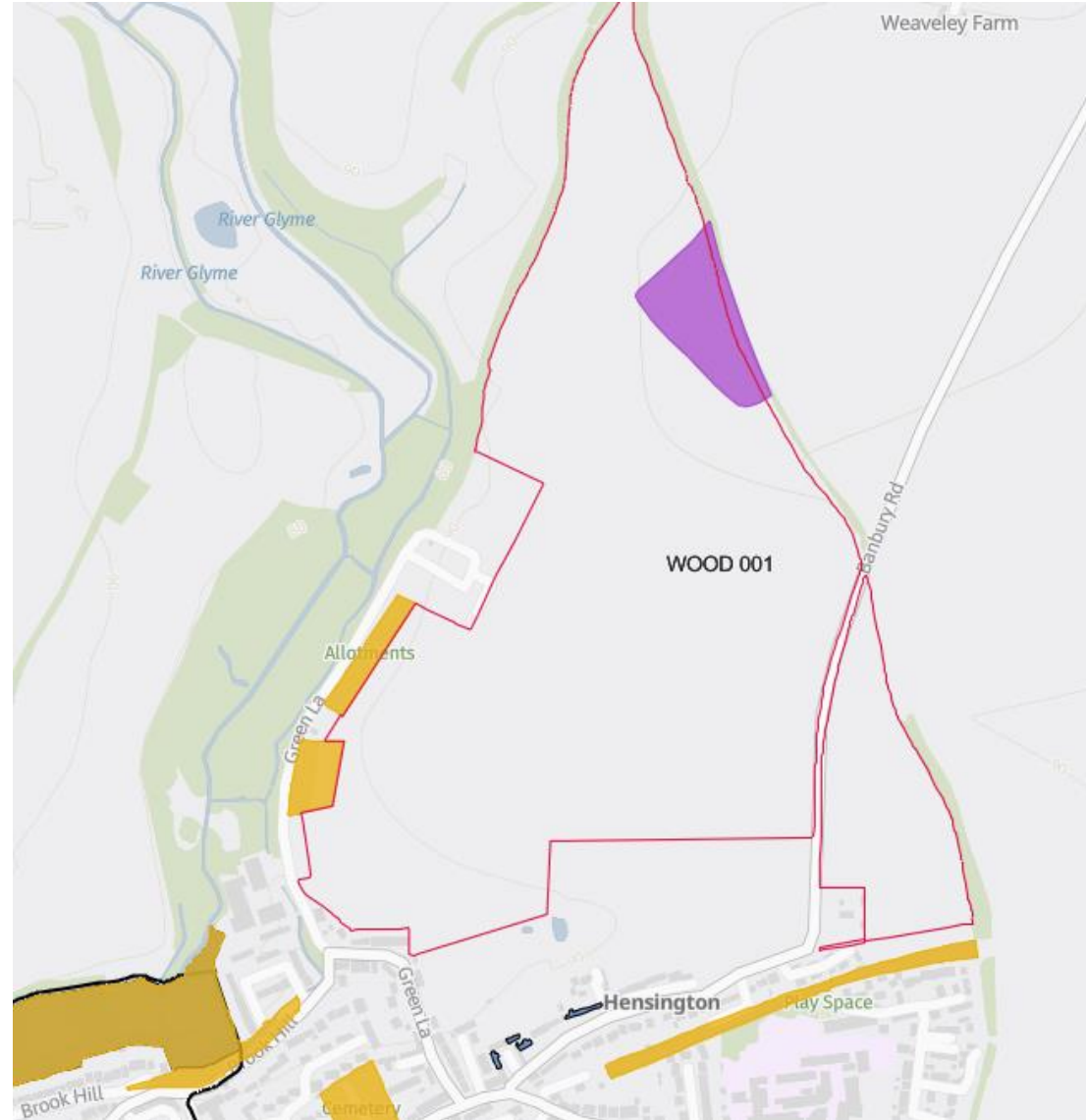
Long Hanborough

- HAN 001 is potentially up to 650 houses by Hanborough Station.



Woodstock

- No figure given but given the size (59.8ha) this would likely be a large strategic housing site.



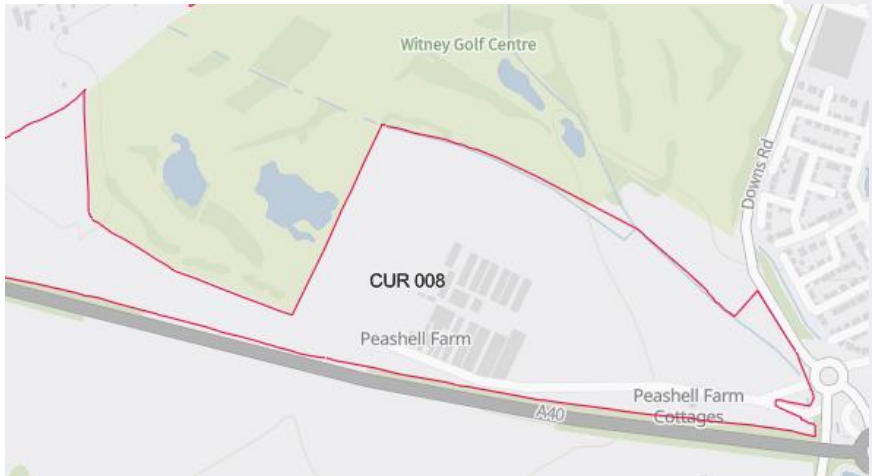
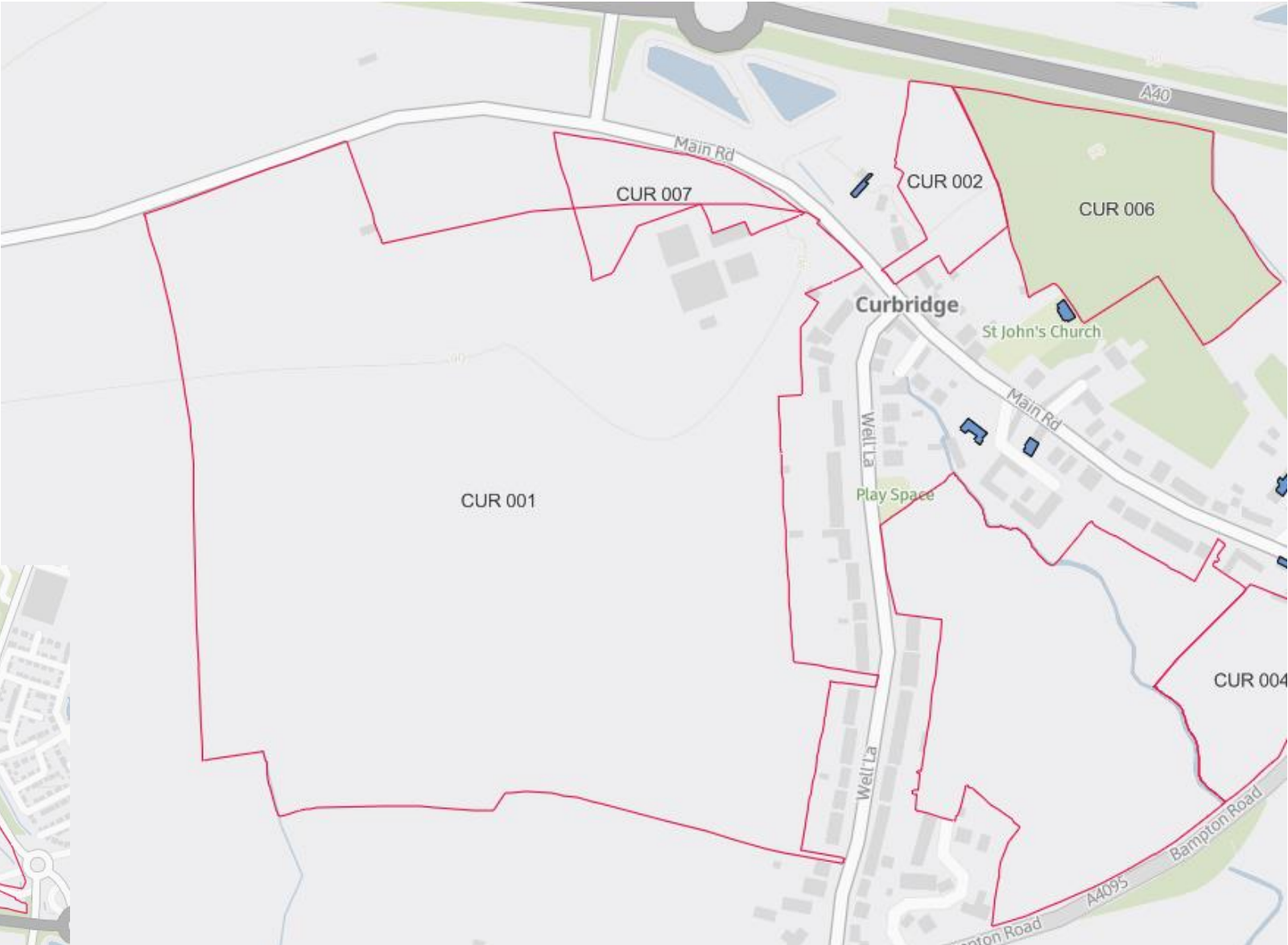
Standlake

- Land at The Downs (STAN 005) could be up to 490 houses.



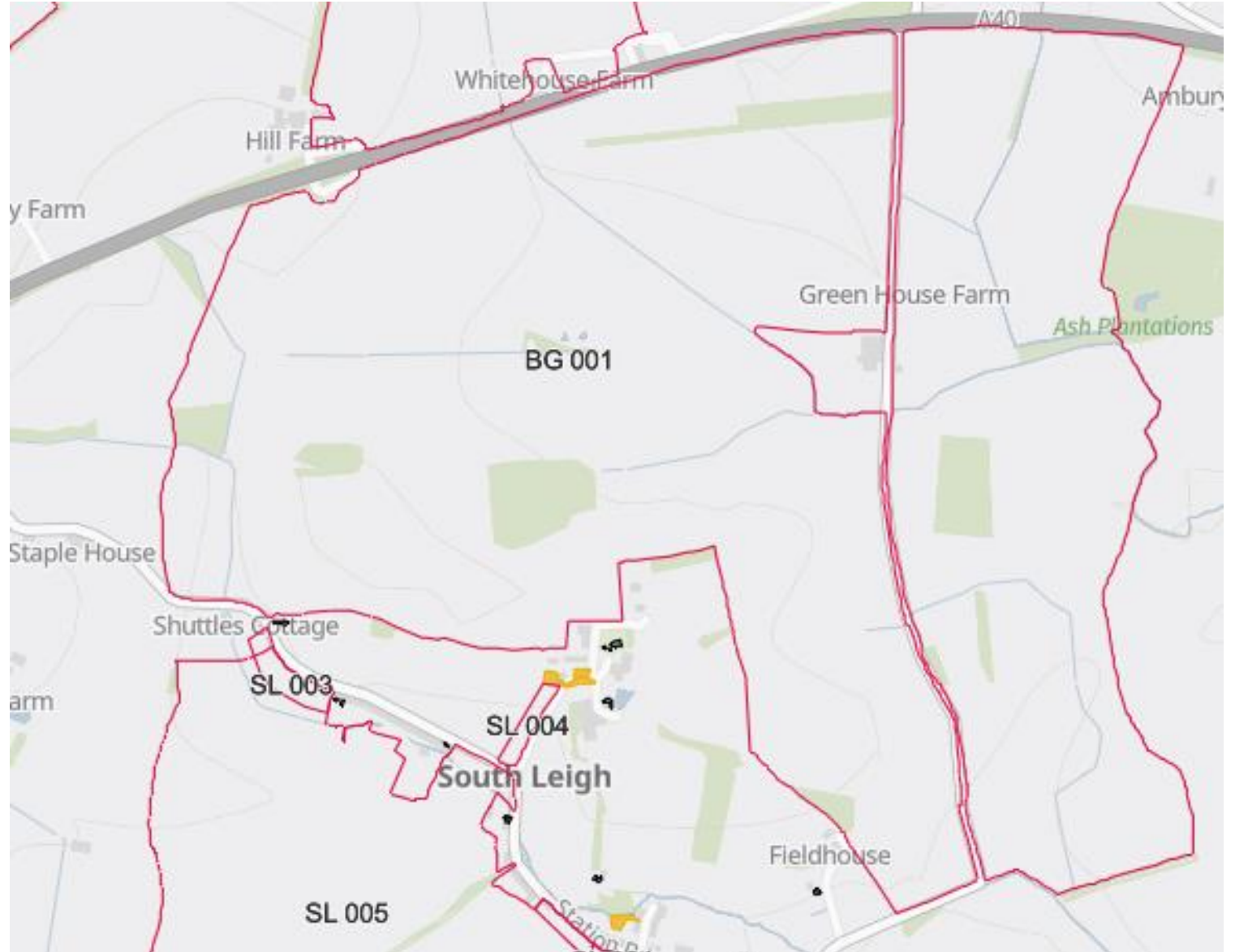
Curbridge

- CUR 001 is up to 400 houses
- CUR 008 is up to 370 houses.



South Leigh

- Land at Barnard Gate potential for a new settlement (Garden Village) to be built at BG 001 that could be up to 3,000 houses.



Why all this matters...

Local Conservative councillors have been concerned about the Lib Dems attempting to keep this information from the public until after the County Council elections. As confirmed by the Executive Member for Planning at WODC [here](#) the preferred options will be released in late May. Conservative councillors have argued that this information should be made public so that's why we have composed this report to highlight where the Lib Dems are potentially planning to build new homes in your local area and the scale at which they plan to do so.

Some will argue that many of these sites won't go ahead but to hit 18,000 new homes with under 8,000 already committed it is clear that large housing sites will be going ahead. Where – well we will find out after the election... how convenient.
